

69th UICH Les Clefs d'Or Congress – Madrid 2025

Dear members, friends,

Continuing on the success of our recent International Congress in Bali, it is my absolute pleasure to announce that **the website for the Madrid 2025 Congress is now live.**

Our International Treasurer, Mathieu Glaser is in the final stages of finalizing the registration fees with strong support from the Spanish Section President, and our host, Borja Martin Guridi. I have been reliably informed that, even though we'll be back in Europe for the 2025 Congress, with incredible support from various contributors, the team is confident that the fees will be comparable to the Bali Congress.



Similar to Bali 2024, as there are no large hotels in the

city centre, the Madrid Congress accommodation will be hosted in 3 hotels. Two of these properties will also be where our meetings will be. Your Executive Committee has decided to allow our members to decide on their accommodation at the time of their registration just as we did for Bali. As before, once a hotel reaches capacity with paid registrations, the members will not be able to choose their hotel and will be automatically assigned to the remaining hotel(s) with rooms. Please be advised that the majority of the room stock we have is at Riu. While two of the host hotels, the <u>Riu Plaza Espana</u> and <u>Barcelo Torre de Madrid</u> are across the street from one another, the distance between these two and our third hotel, <u>Melia Princessa</u>, is a quick 4-5 minute walk. For accommodation details, please visit the Congress website in the coming days.

The **Education Committee** has been diligently working on delivering a truly memorable day once again. I am delighted to inform you that the committee already shortlisted a list of great speakers and all will be announced on the Congress website in the coming weeks with full bios.



2024 Seminar by Japan Concierge Association and Les Clefs d'Or Japan

We held the seminar at Cerulean Tower TOKYU hotel in Shibuya, Tokyo. It consists of two parts and the first part was a lecture by Mr. Yoshihiro Miwa, Professor of Hospitality and Tourism faculty of Meikai University, titled 'DX and Concierge, and the spreading world beyond it. The second part was a talk by Mr. James Ridenour of the 1st Vice president-UICH, the chief concierge at Next Hotel Melbourne, about DX usage example in the workplace of concierge.

Professor Miwa's lecture began by discussing the impression that the word of 'Digital' has and how generative AI differs from humans. Quoting the results of survey and common examples, then he talked about the penetration of digital technology into every field around us is causing a major digital transformation that is changing people's behavior patterns and even sense of values on a global scale. On the other hand, as the human touch may be thought to be valuable, he said that the current situation where the digitalization is slow in the hospitality industry. The core focus is that accommodation is not just accommodation but what we can do through it. From that we learned it is important to identify what is the benefit to be gained and what needs to be protected, and it is also essential to convey the concierge mindset with knowledge deepen through the real experience, to the next generation that has grown up in a fully digital world.

In the continual second part, Mr. James RIDENOUR reaffirmed our strengths and introduced study cases incorporating into generative AI in the concierge field.

Especially the thought of "Hybrid AI" utilizing data based on reliable information and a trust network built up in the workplace rather than using general data, has the potential to connect digitalization to the better concierge services. Lastly, we all participants truly appreciated both valuable lectures.


